The “Common Reporting Standard (“CRS”) for Automatic Exchange of Financial Account Information (“AEoI”)” released by the Organisation of Economic Cooperation and Development (“OECD”) proposes a new global standard that will require, as enforced by local enabling legislation, financial institutions to review and collect information that will enable them to identify where account holders are liable to pay tax and to provide relevant information to the local tax administration authorities. CRS is commonly known as the global version of Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act (“FATCA”) which is a US tax regulation and has become effective starting from 2014.

Hong Kong Government has committed to implement CRS on a reciprocal basis with appropriate partners in other jurisdictions. Similar to FATCA, CRS compliance requires in-scope financial institutions to implement new or enhanced processes and systems around governance, KYC / due diligence, monitoring and reporting.
