### The talk will cover:

This talk takes a practical and practitioner-driven approach to the law and procedure relating to the appointment of judicial trustees, and the supervisory role of the Court in that regard. Attendees will acquire a robust initial understanding of the judicial trustee regime in the Trustee Ordinance, and of the process for making an application to the Court to appoint a judicial trustee. We will also consider the role and utility of a judicial trustee in the context of resolving seemingly intractable trust problems and disputes, best practices for appointing a judicial trustee, and, from the perspective of a trustee that has been appointed a judicial trustee, his ongoing liabilities and obligations.

### About the speaker

Stefano Mariani (MA (Oxon), MSc (LSE)) heads the tax and trusts practice at Deacons. He was called to the Bar of England & Wales and is admitted as a solicitor-advocate with higher rights of audience in Hong Kong. He is an Adjunct Associate Professor of the Faculty of Law of the University of Hong Kong, the Hon. Secretary of the Hong Kong Trustees' Association, a Trusts and Estates Practitioner (STEP), and an honorary fellow of the Asian Institute of International Financial law. He is the co-author of the *Encyclopaedia of Hong Kong Taxation* – the seminal Hong Kong textbook on revenue law, and has been widely published in academic and industry journals.
