Diamond Cab was founded in 2011 to provide point-to-point transportation services for wheelchair users. It has 7 barrier-free cabs that allow wheelchair users to board directly and provides a legal and safe transportation means for wheelchair users and their carers. As of mid-April 2016, Diamond Cab had successfully completed over 100,000 barrier-free trips.

Having experienced difficulties travelling with her wheelchair-bound mother, Doris was determined to set up her own social enterprise – Diamond Cab, introducing 5 wheelchair-accessible taxis to Hong Kong in 2011. Diamond Cab was established with a social mission to provide much-needed, quality point-to-point transport to the disabled, elderly and able-bodied.

Doris was awarded Finalist (Asia Pacific) of Cartier Women's Initiative Awards 2013, Hong Kong Winner of Chivas The Venture 2015 and JESSICA Most Successful Women 2015.
