Steven was awarded a first-class LL.B. and called to the Bar of England and Wales in 2006. Steven teaches the Equity and Trusts courses for undergraduate students, the Principles of Equity and Trusts course on the Juris Doctor course and, in 2013, introduced the Principles of Art, Antiquities, Cultural Heritage and the Law course to the LLM programme at the Chinese University of Hong Kong. Steven has presented continuing professional development courses for solicitors in Hong Kong on many topics associated with equity and trusts, and art law. Steven's research interests include equity and the law of trusts, art and cultural heritage law, and legal history.

An issue that most trustees encounter is a settlor who does not really want to settle. This short talk considers the effects of the doctrine of sham and the concept of illusory trusts for professional trustees after *Kan Lai Kwan v Poon Lok To Otto & HSBC International Trustee Ltd* [2014] HKEC 1174 and *JSC Mezhdunarodniy Promyshlenniy Bank and another v Pugachev (Pugachev v. Pugachev)* [2017] EWHC 2426 (Ch).
