How to Accelerate Digital Financial Inclusion in the Times of COVID-19 – The Case of Digital Banks

Digital financial inclusion has created unheralded opportunities for unbanked populations. Digital financial services are now available in more than 80 countries across the world, some achieving significant scale. Most have built on the digital approaches that traditional banks have used to adapt their in-person services. COVID-19 has further increased the usage of digital channels by customers and accelerated the innovation of disruptive solutions, especially digital-only banks. Asia and Pacific is encouraging the growth of digital banks nowadays: Hongkong and Singapore are the front runners, and Malaysia and Thailand are likely to follow. Fully digital banking services are also operational in China, South Korea, Australia, Japan, and India. What are the key success factor, what are the lessons learnt from both the regulator and bank's perspective. How can we replicate the success to emerging markets?
