Several new outbound personal date rules have just been issued – companies handling all outbound transfers of personal information, even to headquarters in Hong Kong and foreign countries, must use the mechanisms prescribed by law. The new requirements also apply to multinational enterprises doing business with China.

The recent \$1.2 billion fine against Didi for non-compliance with personal information law as well as penalties against financial institutions found in violation shows Chinese regulators will continue to have robust enforcement in the data protection and cybersecurity law space.

In this webinar, we will share information and update on:

- China's enforcement against non-compliance with personal information protection
- Suggested compliance actions
